

2010 Apprentice Application

Purpose: The Apprenticeship program is designed to give youth (ages 16 and older) the opportunity to experience theatre as a professional artist and teacher. The apprentice will shadow a mentor Teaching Artist for the duration of the camp program, as well as directing their peers in a scene for the final performance.

Attendance: All students must attend each session and arrive on time. Concessions will be made for illness, family emergencies, or sufficient advanced notice to the Education Outreach Coordinator if a session will be missed.

Compensation: In compensation for their work, the Apprentice will receive a half scholarship for their enrollment in the camp, excluding the nonrefundable \$50 deposit. The remaining balance of 175.00 must be paid in full by July 5, 2010, regardless of which session the student is enrolled in.

To apply: Please fill out all of the questions listed below to the best of your ability. Each session only has slots available for two (2) Apprentices. The selected students will be notified by June 30, 2010.

Application Questions:

1. Please list below your experiences with theatre and all aspects of the arts (painting, sculpting, photography, seeing live theatre, etc.) that you have participated in over the years.

2. Why do you want to join this program? What are you hoping to learn or gain from this experience? Be specific.

3. Describe in a paragraph an experience you have had in theatre or related to theatre that made you want to further your learning and gain more experience in theater.

4. Which acting topics/techniques would you be interested in learning more about/focusing on during your enrollment in the program?

5. Session 1 of the camp runs from July 12-31 (Mondays to Saturdays), 10am – 3pm. Session 2 runs from August 2-21 (Mondays to Saturdays), 10 am-3pm Do you have any conflicts? Please list the date, time, and reason for conflict.
